

## ANNULMENTS\*

Original or Certified copies of the following are required:

1. Baptismal Certificate for the Petitioner and Respondent from the Church of Baptism (current copy, not older than 6 months).
2. Original or Certified copy of the Church Marriage Certificate (from the Church in which the marriage is recorded.)
3. Certified copy of Civil marriage license OR Certificate of Declaration of Informal marriage, if applicable. Current copy, not older than 6 months.
4. Original or Certified Copy of the final divorce decree or civil annulment. Current copy, not older than 6 months old
5. Original or Certified copy of the death certificate for any marriage ending in death.

\*Before you can begin the annulment process, your divorce must be finalized for at least one year.

There is a form that needs to be completed in its entirety prior to submission to the Tribunal. An Annulment Advocate can assist you in the final completion of this form.

NOTE: There is an appellate fee of \$100.
